



Phonics, Story Reading and Drama

3hrs M-F (12:30-3:30)

This intensive is designed for early achievers. Students will learn and/or practice major phonics rules and read a variety of story books associated with the phonics conventions. Young learners will showcase their skills through role plays, and puppet shows and will bring learned stories to life. Students will also make costumes and props for the plays.



Speech, Debate and Writing

3hrs M-F (Jr. Sr.12:30-3:30)

Students will learn formal and informal debate and speech structures. Students will learn the characteristic of a good stage voice. In this intensive, the students will gain fluency and confidence.

Students will learn and practice a multitude of writing formats. A strong focus will be given to the writing formats used in school and academic writing. Students will improve writing content, organization, style and language.



STEAM Program 3hrs M-F (Sr.9:00 - 12:00) (Jr. 12:30-3:30)

This program is designed for students who are looking for opportunities to develop their science, technology, engineering, arts, and math skills. Using technologies like LittleBits, coding and robotics, students will utilize Little Mountain's Design Cycle to create innovative products, and solutions. Students will expand their creative capacities, and their communication, collaboration, and design skills.



ESL & ESL Transition

6hrs M-F (9:00-3:30)

This intensive is ideal for those students who wish to transition out of ESL and will aid in ESL placement test success.

- **Vocab and Grammar:** Students will work independently through age and level appropriate grammar and vocabulary programs with the aid of a facilitator. The facilitator will monitor the whole learning process and give a spelling test at the end.
 - **Reading Log:** Students will read level appropriate storybooks and complete reading logs and vocabulary building worksheets.
 - **Writing Skills:** Students will improve their basic writing skills through a wide range of content based reading and topics using the Fish curriculum.
 - **Speech:** Students will participate in a group presentation once a week to gain speaking fluency.
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Critical Thinking and Writing

3hrs M-F (12:30-3:30)

This intensive is ideal for those students who wish to hone their critical thinking and writing skills. Students will learn how to recognize the anatomy of an argument, how to identify strong and weak arguments, and how to consume and judge the claims they encounter in daily life. Students will produce their own written arguments to demonstrate effective reasoning.
